Classroom Assistant Job Requirements:

- Age 18+
- Experience working with children
- Ability to communicate kindly to children and lead crafts and games
- Ability to arrive on time, help prep and organize, and help clean up after service
- Classroom management skills to help each kid be in a safe, calm, and respectful environment
- You do not need to be a part of The Commons community
- You do not need to consider yourself a Christian or religious

- 3rd Grade to 5th Grade

1. Resume: Including previous work history, skills, and at least 3 references
2. Answer the following questions in the email you send:
 - Name, email, phone number, date of birth, address
 - Why are you applying for the role of kids classroom assistant?
 - What prior experience do you have working with kids?
 - Do you have any previous church or religious history that you'd like to share about? (This is not necessary for this role, but we'd love to know where you are coming from if you are open to sharing.)
 - In this type of work environment, what do you feel gifted in and what do you think will be challenging?
3. Once you send in those 2 things we will email you a link to complete your Background Check online.

Once those things are sent in we will reach out to you if we would like to set up a meeting with a staff member to go over job description and do an interview with The Commons Leadership Team.
